Class Sizes in S1 and S2 **English and Mathematics**

Secondary schools in Scotland have been allocated additional staff to reduce the number of pupils in S1 and S2 classes in English and Mathematics.

In the past, the maximum size of nonpractical classes in S1 and S2 has been 33 pupils.



In King's Park Secondary. we are very pleased to have this additional resource which will allow **English and Mathematics** teachers to give more support to all pupils.

In S1 and S2 English and Mathematics this session, it is possible that some classes of more able pupils will be over 20 pupils, to allow smaller classes for pupils who require greater support. However, the average number of pupils in S1 and S2 English and Mathematics classes will be 20 or lower.
