
Art & Design Department S1 / S2 Course structure



Homework drawing is a vital and important part of the S1 / S2 programme. Parents are able to help students in this by offering help on the following points

- Students' work should fill the page.
 Please support the department by
 reminding your child to ensure that
 all images should be drawn to 'fit
 the page'
- Students should spend at least one and a half hours on an A4 tonal study. Please support the department by reminding your child of the time they should spend on their work
- Students must look for as much detail as possible in their drawings. Please support the department by reminding your child that the use of detail in their work will ensure higher quality detail in work will take time, this is why we recommend a minimum time of one and a half hours on any one drawing on A4 paper.
- Students should shade in all their work using a large variety of tones (shade light to dark, tone black to white). Please support your child by reminding them that they should look for and use a large variety of tones in their drawings.
- Students should ensure that all homework is completed on time and that parents have signed all completed work. Please support the Art & Design department by ensuring that all homework is completed and signed.
- Parents please support your child in the completion of homework by ensuring a quiet area where they may work - away from distraction in order that they may focus and concentrate on the homework task
- Parents please support the Art & Design department by encouraging your child's artistic development by offering 'How to Draw' books or books on varied artists / designers or visits to Glasgow varied and wonderful museums and Art Galleries.
