Please read the following information. We appreciate that this may be inconvenient for some but you will understand that these procedures are necessary to ensure the safety of all children and adults as we re-open the campus.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP TIMES

- Please stick to the times you were allocated previously and do not arrive before your allocated time.
- If you are entering the school grounds please follow the one-way system arrows and keep moving through the playground at a two metre distance from others and **STAY BEHIND THE CONES.**
- We will aim to have your children ready at the correct pick up time. Please make sure your child knows if you will be meeting them or if they should make their own way home. Children who walk home without an adult will be dismissed from the front of the school.
- We ask that only one adult per child / family enters the school grounds to keep footfall to a minimum Children attending BREAKFAST CLUB may enter any time after 08:15 by the usual door (93p or 41p)

LUNCHES

- Lunch breaks are staggered and children may bring their own packed lunch or have one from the canteen. Hot lunches will be available.

WATER BOTTLES

- Please ensure your child brings one or two bottles of water with them to school. Please make sure bottles are washed thoroughly when the children bring them home each day.

HANDWASHING AND GENERAL HYGIENE

- All children and adults must continue to wash their hands at regular intervals. Hand sanitising stations are available throughout the campus. You may wish to provide your own sanitiser and / or some hand cream.
- There are three cleaners employed in the campus throughout the day and all surfaces are continually cleaned
- Classroom resources are disinfected every day
- Please do not allow your child to bring unnecessary items from home such as toys and mobile phones



HOMEWORK

- Most homework tasks will continue on Google classrooms.

PE

- PE lessons are permitted outside only at present. Your child's teacher will let you know when your child will be having a PE lesson and the children should wear on PE days.
